I'm looking forward to passing on some of my thoughts and experiences with you as we explore voice, music, and performance. I've been a vocal coach for almost 30 years. I've been performing professionally for over 25 and I've been directing musicals around Canada since 2008. Recently, I had the pleasure of directing *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* and playing Callahan in *Legally Blonde* for Theatre Under

the Stars in Vancouver. As a director some of my favourite work includes *Avenue Q* (Arts Club Theatre), *Les Miserables* (Chemainus Theatre), *Fiddler on the Roof* (Persephone Theatre), as well as *Into the Woods* and *The Light in the Piazza* (with my own theatre company, Patrick Street Productions). As an actor some of my favourites include starring roles in *She Loves Me*, *My Fair Lady*, *Beauty & the Beast*, and *The Music Man*. But the work I find the most rewarding is as a theatre educator. Aside from coaching a roster of amazing private voice students, I'm also the Founder and Program Director of the Arts Club Musical Theatre Intensive, a youth summer program for young talent who are passionate about Musical Theatre and want to experience a professional level training program. 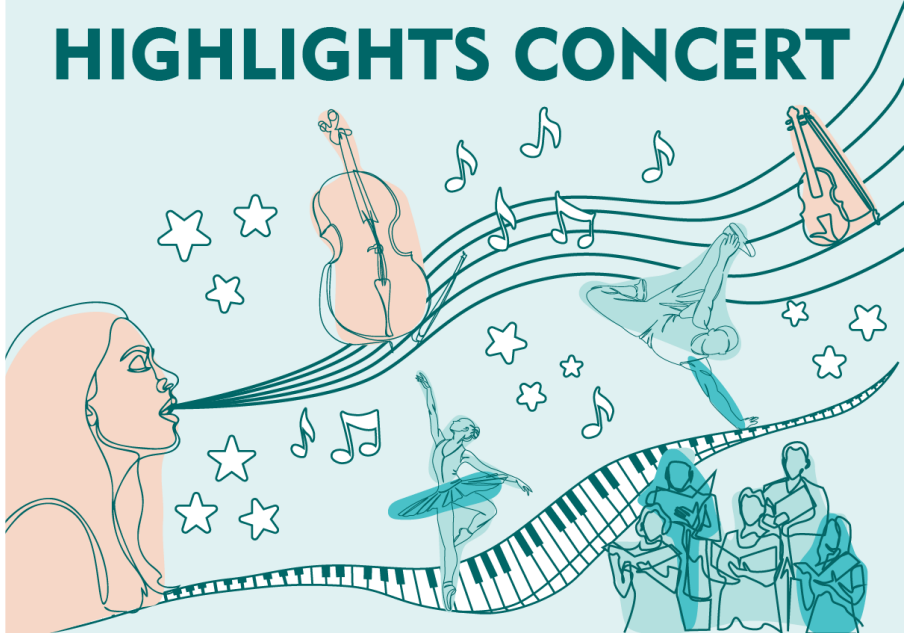
